This workshop is for clinicians working in NGO's, CAMHS and Maternal MHS who have no/minimal training and experience around observing parent-child interaction and structuring the observations to usefully describe the relationships, formulate and plan interventions. In Infant Mental Health it is essential to assess the infant's relationship with parents/carers and the most commonly accepted processes use film of interaction. This workshop will support clinicians to begin filming interaction, analyse the film and develop a formulation utilising the Relationship Problems Checklist [RPCL] and the Parent-Infant Relationship Global Assessment Scale [PIR-GAS] from Axis II of DC: 0-3R.

The workshop is for a maximum of 20 clinicians. Participants will need to do some reading and film a parent and child [0-4 years] ahead of the workshop. Details regarding this will be sent to participants as soon as registration is confirmed.
